What the P & F does for our College community:

The P & F Association meets twice per term and discusses issues relevant to the parents and students at the College. We provide additional funds to the College through fundraising activities. We encourage and welcome parents to our meetings. The meetings provide an opportunity for parents to have a voice in decisions that affect themselves and their children. Some of the topics we discuss include: the reporting system for our children's grades; determination of the elective subjects provided; how the money raised by the P & F is spent and details of excursions and events that are compulsory in the College calendar. A parent is free to raise any issue they wish for discussion.

The P & F at Woodlawn uses the membership fees collected to cover our costs of postage, stationery and hospitality. We also use the fees to pay our membership with the NSW Parents Council (NSWPC). NSWPC is recognised as the voice of non-government parents in the general community. These issues have previously included comment on such broad ranging issues as the NAPLAN assessments and your child's preferred learning style.
