



St. John's College Woodlawn 2021 HSC Results

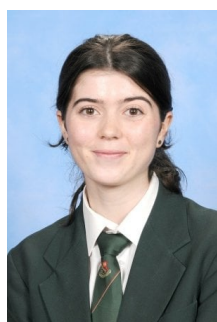

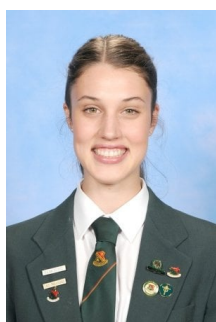
College Dux: Molly O'Toole
